WILLIAMSBURG – August 29, 2012 – Leebcor Services LLC has been awarded a \$6.37 million contract from the United States Army Corps of Engineers, Louisville District, for the construction of a new U.S. Army Reserve center in Panama City, Fla.

The proposed 17,000-square-foot facility will provide the Florida Army Reserve with training space and a detached high-bay organizational maintenance shop.

Design on this project is set to begin in October 2012 and will be carried out by architectural design firm Michael Baker, Jr., Inc. with offices in Moon Township, Penn. Construction is slated to begin March 2013 with anticipated completion by early 2014.
